Arrestors will be required for all other riding at Bear Creek.
- Children must be supervised by their Parents/legal Guardian



DIRECTIONS TO BEAR CREEK ASPEN TRAILHEAD

- Turn on to Westside Rd from Hwy 97 and drive approximately 5km to **Bear Lake Main** (**do not** turn onto Bear Creek Rd which is ~1 km from Hwy 97 turnoff)
- Turn left on Bear Lake Main. You will cross a cattleguard and road turns to gravel after ~1km.
- Continue up past the Motocross Track (~3km on left) and the Tolko Yard (~6-7 km on left)
- Slow down when you see gravel pile on right
- Turn off Bear Lake Main at the old Lower Pits signs and follow Events signs up the road ~2 km to Trailhead.
